Students wishing to apply for a Plainfield Tri Kappa scholarship will be required to submit the following:

1. Application Form/Activities Form (please complete both sides)
2. Personal statement of goals, stating applicant's educational plans, career aspirations, and why he/she feels qualified for the Tri-Kappa scholarship
3. One (1) copy of high school transcripts signed by a high school administrator or guidance counselor.
4. Two (2) sealed recommendation forms from a high school administrator, guidance counselor, teacher, instructor or employer. Completed recommendation forms should be returned to the student in sealed envelope and should be submitted by the student along with other requested documentation. Alternatively, recommendation may be emailed directly to scholarship@plainfieldtrikappa.org noting your name in the subject line.

Any relative of a current or past member or officer of Tri Kappa is ineligible for this scholarship.

Members of the Delta Pi Chapter's scholarship committee may contact qualified applicants to schedule a brief interview as part of the application process.
